This fall, our students took a new version of the IOWA ASSESSMENT TEST that was developed to be aligned with the new Common Core Curriculum Standards. The Common Core Curriculum Standards are being implemented this year, but the test assesses what the students learned last year. With that being said, our students did very well and are performing above grade level in almost all areas. For example, if the score in in Math is a 7.9, that means that they are performing as well as a seventh grade student (7) in the ninth (.9) month of school. The chart also indicates that the longer students attend St. Mary, the more their scores increase each year. Some grade levels were not tested in certain areas and that is indicated with N/A.
