In Today's Gospel

Last week, we saw Andrew and Simon Peter encounter Jesus for the first time. When Andrew first met Jesus, he asked him where he was staying. Jesus responded, "Come, and see." (Jn 1:39) This is an open invitation to the disciples and to us.

In today's gospel, some time has passed since that first meeting. John the Baptist has been arrested. Andrew and Simon Peter have returned home. They were not yet ready to abandon everything and follow Jesus. That's okay. Jesus did not give up on them, and he does not give up on us. When we are ready, he will be there.
